The original aims of the proposed project were as follows:

To develop appropriate teaching materials that are focused on the aspects of Lithuanian culture, economics, politics, science and social life in order to compensate for the lack of teaching materials of this type. The materials would have been designed to cover all 20 topics of the MA Lithuanian language syllabus and comprise both reading and listening (or video) files. These would be various articles from Lithuanian newspapers, magazines, journals, audio or video recordings of Lithuanian TV and radio programmes (e.g. news), etc. Following the latest language teaching methodology, the materials were to have been made available via Moodle as well as in a hardcopy during the class.
